hello everyone. I am abdulaziz alshareef . Today im going to explain how people play chess . The chess is a strategy game,the goal of this game is how to kill the king by your plans and your strategies,it required two player. play on checkered board there are 36 squares on the board . Each player have 16 pieces , one **(king)** , one **(qween)**, two **(rook)**, two **(horses or knight)**,two**(bishop)**, and eight **(soliders)**.

Every specific pieces has different moves , for example the **the king** moves one step for ward or backward, right or left . **The queen** can move any number of squares along a rank,file,or diagonal, but can not leap over other pieces. **A rook** can move any number of squares along a rank or file , but cannot leap over other pieceec. **The horses** moves to any of the closest squares that are not on the same rank ,file , or diagonal. (this the move as (L) shape : two squares vertically and one square horizontally , or two squares horizontally and one square vertically. The horses are the only pieces can leap over other pieces. **A bishop** can move any number of squares diagonally, but cannot leap over the pieces. **The soldiers** can move forward to the unoccupied square immediately in front of it on the same file , or on its first move it can advance two squares along the same file ,provided both squares are unoccupied (black dots in the diagram), or the soldiers can capture an opponents piec on a square diagonally in front of it on an adjacent file , by moving .to that square
