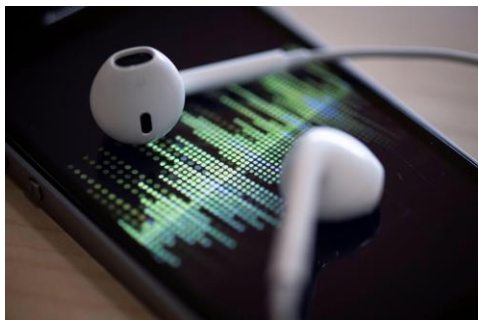

LESSON PLAN



Stage		Time
1	Go over the homework: correct conditionals worksheet and go over questions/doubts; go over the vocabulary exercises. Continue working on the other 2 vocabulary exercises in pairs. Correct the exercises on the board.	15 mins
2	Warm-up: The teacher will ask students to demonstrate a role-play. The teacher will divide the class in pairs and will assign certain topics. The whole class stands up. The teacher will pull topics from a hat, and pairs/groups will have to improvise a one-minute dialogue and present it to the whole class.	15 mins
3	❖ In class activity: In pairs/groups, create a role play: Create a role play using the 10 new, academic words. Think about a scenario: where the conversation takes place, who is talking, what the topic is about. The conversation needs to make sense and to have a beginning, middle, and an interesting ending. Make it fun, crazy, creative, and different! You will have 30 minutes to complete this activity.	30 mins
4	Presentations: Each pair/group will go to the front of the class to role-paly their dialogue.	30 mins
5	Error Correction: The teacher will take notes of the grammar/pronunciation mistakes that students make during the whole activity. Then, he/she will display them on the board and/or create a lesson regarding the mistakes made if necessary.	8 mins
6	Homework assignment: Choose an article online (2 pages minimum). It can be on a newspaper website, magazine, or anything you find interesting such as a science article, politics, invention, psychology, etc. Try not to choose anything too technical because it might be boring for some people. Choose something you like, but it can also be very interesting to most people, for example, something about artificial intelligence, science, etc.	2 mins
